

## Choosing Electric Fence Supplies

If you are searching around for the best electric fence supplies, you need to know a bit about what you need in order to have a state of the art electric fence that will keep predators at bay while containing your livestock. Knowing the items you need to install an electric fence is not enough. You will need to decide how large of an area you need to fence in and what type of animals you want to contain and even what predators are in your area. If you have chickens you may only want to keep out small animals such as fox or badgers, however, deer may be a problem with your garden. The same type of electric fencing will not do the job for both situations.

The very first thing you need to know is that you will need to choose between battery energisers or mains energisers, then you will need fence insulators, polyrope or polytape, or you can choose to use electric netting in some cases.

For larger animals, polytape can work well especially for paddock fencing as horses learn quickly that they will receive a shock if they touch the fence. This way they will run in their area and stay away from the electric fence. Of course, you will need more than one strand of polyrope or polytape if you are containing large animals such as horses or cattle. Goats and sheep may not be large animals, however, they are a bit stubborn and you will need to use at least two to three strands of polyrope or polytape.

If you are more concerned about keeping herons away from your garden pond, rabbits out of your vegetable, or cats away from your flowerbed, then you may wish to use electric netting. You can find electric netting that will blend very well with the background so it not take away from the beauty but will keep pests out of your pond, garden, or flowerbed.

Once you know what size of electric fence you need, next you will be able to find the best energiser for your fence. You should ensure that whether you wish to a main energiser or a battery energiser is that you purchase one that has enough power for the fencing you choose.

You can choose either green polyrope or polytape, along with green posts or you can choose white. The choice of course is up to you as to whether you wish it to blend in with the background or if you want it to stand out and be noticed.

In most cases, if you are looking for a cost effective way in which to protect your property or livestock, polytape is often quite a bit cheaper than regular electric fencing. Of course, it may not be as durable against the elements.

The best way in which to learn what type of electric fencing you need in your situation is by visiting local electric fence suppliers. Most electric fence suppliers will be more than willing to assist you in finding all the electric fence supplies you may need including electric fencing kits, rabbit netting, or even enough electric fencing supplies for a large farm.
